Aluminum Hurricane Panels are lightweight and can be custom fit for any window. These panels are typically stored and then mounted over the windows and doors prior to a storm. While the panels are typically completely aluminum, translucent 6" and 12" panels can be added to give you the ability to illuminate your home in daylight hours before, during, and after a hurricane.

Our Hurricane Panels which are manufactured in our own facility, not only carry statewide product approval, but are engineered with thicker metal to add to your protection. Our panels are tested to perform in wind zones in excess of 150 mph in accordance with the NEW 2004 Florida Building Code wind standard (ASCE 7-98). They are tested for large missile impact from wind born debris in accordance with the state of Florida and Miami-Dade requirements.
